One of the largest new hospital developments will house the best of Manchester's healthcare in one state of the art site, serving more than a million patients a year.

The £500m complex of hospitals on Oxford Road, which includes the largest single-site children's hospital within the UK, is due to open in Summer 2009.

The new integrated complex will bring together services currently provided by five Manchester hospitals, Booth Hall Children's Hospital, Royal Manchester Children's Hospital, Manchester Royal Infirmary, Saint Mary's Hospital for Women and Children and the Royal Eye Hospital.

Pharmacy support offices on the 4th floor were furnished with Trios single wave workstations and Stanzo task seating. Concerto multi-purpose seating with writing pallets was chosen for The Education and Teaching Seminar Room which provide ergonomically designed seating which keeps the bodies anthropometrics at a comfortable angle whilst using the writing pallet to support writing materials. Meeting room

furniture was from the Alto range with stylish chrome framed tables teamed with the Alto G3 multi-purpose seating.

Level 5 is home to the research teams and the open plan offices were furnished with Trios Radial and Wave Workstations and Stanzo Task Seating, providing a light and airy working environment for the staff. The popular Venue modular benching was teamed with glass top circular coffee tables which provided a relaxing and bright waiting area.

Leading up to the 6th floor, a mixture of Trios Double Wave and Planar (height adjustable) Rectangular Workstations were teamed with Lily Task Seating, providing staff in the Analysis Room open plan offices with furniture which was ergonomic, stylish and packed with the environmental credentials synonymous with this state of the arts building.
