The Royal Alexandra Children's Hospital

The New hospital was built to replace the ageing 19th century hospital building which has served the Sussex area for over 125 years. The new facility provides a safe, healthy, child and young person orientated environment for the

The installation which was completed in June, it was staged over seven floors and is home to ICU units, respiratory wards, speech therapy offices, consulting rooms, and parents accommodation to name just a small section.
